Minutes

Disc Golf

The PACE Board heard a presentation from David Gascon about Disc Golf and what this could look like in Battle Ground. The board discussed the logistics of cost and set-up for a course. There is room for fundraising and can be set up gradually before building a true course. Members were interested in hearing a proposal for an initial spot to put in a couple of hoops. It was suggested that Mr. Gascon return to the board with a proposal discussing location, funding, and general logistics. It was also suggested that Mr. Gascon review the PROS plan to see what parks have been designated as ideal candidates for disc golf. Once Mr. Gascon has a proposal, the board could either approve, modify, or deny the proposal. If funding is needed from City Council, the board could make a recommendation to City Council for this project.

PROS Plan

Without a quorum, it was recommended to set a work session with the PACE Board and Planning Commission prior to the July 6<sup>th</sup> Planning Commission meeting which was set to hear a presentation on the PROS plan. Staff will coordinate with the two boards to re-schedule this recommendation.

Holiday Banner

Board discussed the timing of street improvements to allow for poles for the holiday banners.

Emily mentioned Evan's term has ended and City Council is in the process of replacing this seat with a new BGHS student.
