THE ISSUE

Many of our daily activities can have an enormous impact on the City's water resources. When storms pass through Battle Ground, the rain water picks up contaminants and then carries them into storm drains and ditch and eventually into our streams, rivers and lakes. These contaminants can include oil and anti-freeze, pesticides and fertilizers, pet waste, sewage from failing septic systems, and sediment from construction and land clearing.
