



2023 Utility Service Rates

Residential (Inside/Outside) & Non-Residential

Inside refers to those properties located within the city limits. *Outside* is any property that receives utility services from the city, but is located outside of the city limits.

Non-Residential refers to commercial customers, churches, and multi-family properties. *Irrigation* refers to those customers who have a dedicated meter for their irrigation system.

Residential unit charges are based on a Winter Water Average (WWA)—the average of water consumption from December to March
 All non-residential accounts' unit charges are based on actual water consumption, as measured by the water meter

Stormwater Drainage

Residential & Non-Residential Stormwater Rates	
Monthly Charge (per ERU)	\$12.50

ERU = Equivalent Residential Unit; typical residential = 1 ERU. Individual property ERU is determined by the engineering department

City Utility Tax.....12% on Water, Sewer, and Stormwater Drainage

A utility tax of 12% is assessed on City of Battle Ground water, sewer, and stormwater utilities. The revenue is dedicated to the general fund and is essential to support public safety (police), parks, and streets.
